This exhibit will ONLY feature Level 1 Miksang works done by JoMar Visions Miksang students and the works will be selected by the JoMar Visions founders and the qualified Miksang instructor Denise Bossarte.

## Event date and times: Friday 27th of February from 7pm to 10pm.

## Showing fee and submission guidelines:

\$8 per piece selected. You can submit as many images as you see fit. All or none may be selected so make sure that you select the images you did that reflect any of the 4 elements studied, purely out of your Miksange Level I practice. Those images can be the ones created in any of the classes or images you created on your own after the course. Images must not be edited. The only accepted adjustment is exposure tweaking for printing purposes. No other tweaking will be accepted. Remember that once you start "working" on them, it ceases to be a pure Miksang practice shot.

Maximum work size is 16"x24" which can be printed in a variety of mediums at the artist choice.

Work must be submitted online through email to jomar@jomarvisions.com, in JPG format. File resolution should be 72 dpi or greater, and no larger than 2MB. Artist will need to indicate the "form/assignment" in the title of the image (Color, Pattern/Texture, Light/Shadow, Space/Dot In Space).

Image files must be named in the following or they will not be accepted:

FILE NAMES: ArtistLastname\_ArtistFirstname\_Height(inches)xWidth(inches)\_Assignment\_Title

(Example: Smith\_John\_20x16\_Dot in Space\_Dot #1).

## Payment method:

Only after we select the images, the artist will know how many of his/her images were entered into the exhibit. We will count how many images of yours were selected and send you a paypal request for that amount that should be paid promtly.

#### Sales:

You keep 100% of your sales and you're responsible to handle your own sales. If you sell during the event, please call one of us (Jo or Mark) to take a photo of you with the client and the sold piece. It is important to us and to you as well. If at all necessary, we have a card swiper if any client needs to pay with credit card and you don't have that facility. In that case, we will take care of receiving the money, paying fees involved with it and pay sales tax on those sales, so we are keeping 5% to cover all that.

Bring lots of cards to give to the guests. Remember, we're always planting little seeds that we never know when they will sprout.

Submission deadline: Saturday 31st of January.

Artist notifications: Monday 2nd of February.

## Art Delivery Date: Monday 23rd of February at 6pm.

There will be no other delivery dates and times so make sure you can make it or have someone to come deliver your work for you.

JoMar Visions has the right to refuse work that is not displayed properly or in a professional manner. Paper pieces should be framed.

All pieces must be wired on the back and ready to hang, and have a temporary tag with artist name and name of the piece.

Take Down Date: Same day as the event but only after all guests are gone.

## Food and Drinks:

All artists will contribute with food and drinks. Each artist brings a little something for the food table and bar.

## Tags

After the images are selected, we will send a word file template for you to fill in your tags. We will then print them so they exhibit in a consistent manner.

# Cancellations:

After payment of the images selected and commitment from the artist to participate, no refunds will be issued.
